SUNY Korea Housing Guidelines for Novel Coronavirus

Academic and Student Affairs February, 6, 2020

1. Purpose: To provide student dormitory management guidelines to prevent the spread of Novel Coronavirus

2. SUNY Korea Housing Management Guidelines

- 1) For General Students
 - Students are allowed to postpone their housing check-in date.
 - All students must have their temperature checked.
 - Hand sanitizers are placed in the dormitory.
 - Announcements will be updated by infection prevention posters
 - Provisional delay and cancellation of community meetings and events within the dormitory.

2) For Students Who Visited China

- Students are not allowed to attend classes or University events until after 14 days from arrival
- Those students who visited China are to self-quarantine in a separate space of IGC dormitory.
- * Self-quarantine students are able to attend classes or University events when no symptoms are detected after 14 days from arrival.
- ① Guideline for Self-quarantine Individuals Living in the Dormitory
 - * Students will be assigned to designated rooms on the first floor of the IGC single-dorm building.
 - * Students will be provided with a thermometer, daily necessities, and meals.

- 2 Guidelines For When the Symptoms Appear During the Self-Quarantine Period
 - When a person who stayed in China within the last 14 days and has fever (above 37.5°C) or respiratory problems (cough, difficulty breathing, throat pain, etc.)
 - When a person who has close contact with a Novel Coronavirus patient (patient's family, friend, etc), and has fever (above 37.5°C) or respiratory problems (cough, difficulty breathing, throat pain, etc.)



- 1) Call 1339 or Community Health Center to follow the instructions and visit the designated medical institution, and
- 2) Call and report to 032-626-1190(SUNY Korea Student Services & Career Team)
- 3) Dormitory Hygiene Management
 - Sanitize self-quarantine areas and other housing facilities in cooperation with IGC Foundation.
 - Place hand sanitizer all around the SUNY Korea Academic Buildings and IGC dormitories
- 4) Follow Emergency Communication Network
 - Emergency managers are available for those who are under the self-quarantine period and in case of emergencies
